

Hon. Aruna Devi Narain was appointed Judge of the Supreme Court of Mauritius and Designated Judge under the International Arbitration Act in 2015. She was formerly Parliamentary Counsel at the Attorney-General's Office and in that capacity worked on the amendments that were made to the International Arbitration Act of Mauritius in 2013. She was also a Director of MIAC and the desk officer on International Arbitration at the Attorney-General's Office from 2011 to 2015 and has been involved in the organisation of the MIAC Conferences in 2012 and 2014.

Hon Narain read law at the London School of Economics (LSE) where she obtained her LL.B and LL.M and was called to the Bar at the Middle Temple in London. She was Deputy Agent for the Republic of Mauritius in the arbitral proceedings brought by Mauritius against the UK in connection with the Chagos Archipelago. She is a member of the UN CEDAW Committee since 2017 and also sits as a member of the Commonwealth Secretariat Arbitral Tribunal.
